M274 Mule – US Airborne – Rob Schorry

On our recent trip to Alaska we stayed in a bed and breakfast in Healy, AK and the owner had put this Mule together from surplus parts.

Mules were introduced to the US Army in 1956 and were used until the 1980s. They were fulltime 4x4 and could carry 1000 lbs of cargo. They were also frequently equipped with weapons, although they gave no protection at all to the driver or passengers who would hang on willy-nilly. Wheelbase was 57” and overall length was 118”. Curb weight was 970 lbs. Max speed was 25 mph in forward, good enough for a cargo carrier.

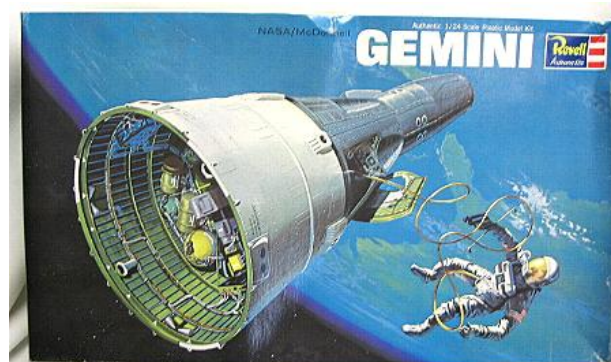


The winner is Robbie!
